

Agency for Sale of Chametz

I, the undersigned, do hereby authorize and empower Rabbi _____ or any subagent, to sell on my behalf, to a gentile, my chametz, including but not limited to any and all chametz in any form and/or combination, in any ratio, and any product which contains even a concern or a doubt of chametz, as well as any and all traces of chametz adhered to any vessels. Likewise do I empower him to sell or rent the dwelling space upon which the chametz stands, as well as any further action to the end that said sale of chametz will be effective and complete. This transaction is to take place prior to the 6th hour of the 14th day of the month of Nissan in the year 5784. All transactions listed above may be done in the manner he or his subagent see fit, by any method and for any price, even a price disproportionate to its value such that the transaction would otherwise be hampered or nullified, even for no compensation at all. This document shall be binding and is to be interpreted in the manner which best satisfies its intended use. This document, declaration and agency have been executed in a serious, binding manner and not merely proforma, effectuated with a valid act of acquisition, effectively, before a duly constituted Bais Din, effective as of this very moment. Notwithstanding any other bill of sale or proof of purchase, from the 6th hour of the 14th day of Nissan, in the year 5784, this document shall also act as a bill of sale, when in the hands of the gentile purchaser, for the aforementioned transaction.
